



## WHAT HAPPENS IF A BUBBLE HAS TO CLOSE OR THERE IS A LOCAL/NATIONAL LOCKDOWN?

Please do not worry that this is imminent and it will be an absolute last resort but we need to give you advanced warning so you know what to expect and can have your own contingency plans in place.

If a whole bubble has to close, you will be alerted via Seesaw and letter as soon as possible. **ALL** pupils and staff in this bubble must self-isolate for the full duration of the time period given including the pupils of keyworkers.

### Remote Learning

Teachers will post work on Seesaw daily for pupils to complete. **There is an expectation that children send their completed tasks back via Seesaw for teachers to assess, give feedback and ensure that the pupils are achieving and progressing with the home learning.**

The home learning will consist of daily English and Maths tasks along with a daily task from another area of the wider curriculum e.g. Science, Geography, History. These tasks will, wherever possible, match the tasks that children would have been doing in school.

The use of online learning apps e.g. TTRockstars/Spelling Shed/ Oxford Owl will also be updated weekly and tracked by the teachers. Pupils have all been sent their QR codes for accessing their own seesaw accounts. If you have not received yours then please contact your class teacher.

If you would struggle with accessing this online learning then please contact the class teacher as soon as possible so that we can put plans in place to ensure an alternative method of working can be arranged.

For safeguarding reasons, teachers will not be live streaming lesson from their homes. However they may upload short videos modelling tasks, if appropriate.

Children self-isolating whilst waiting for test result for themselves or a member of their household. Teachers will provide home learning activities that match the objectives that are being covered by the rest of the class for the children to complete IF THEY ARE WELL ENOUGH TO DO SO. Children have an individual log in for TT Rockstars (Y2-6) and Spelling Shed (Y1-6) which they will be asked to practice every day. They will also be directed to Oxford Owl reading website so they have access to age appropriate reading books online. This will be through the online learning platform Seesaw (and/or Tapestry for EYFS). Teachers will communicate with parents through Seesaw so parents can ask if they are unsure what their child needs to do.

Children are self-isolating for 10-14 days as they have had a positive test a member of their house-hold has a positive result. Teachers will provide home learning activities that match the objectives that are being covered by the rest of the class for the children to complete IF THEY ARE WELL ENOUGH TO DO SO. Children have an individual log in for TT Rockstars (Y2-6) and Spelling Shed (Y1-6) which they will be asked to practice every day. They will also be directed to Oxford Owl reading website so they have access to age appropriate reading books online. This will be through the online learning platform Seesaw (and/or Tapestry for EYFS). **There is an expectation that children send their completed tasks back via Seesaw for teachers to assess, give feedback and ensure that the pupils are achieving and progressing with the home learning.**

Teachers will communicate with parents through Seesaw so parents can ask if they are unsure what their child needs to do. Teachers or Teaching Assistants will also phone once per week to check on the well-being of the child and answer questions about the work set.

A whole bubble (class) is isolating for 14 days due to a positive case in that bubble (on advice from PHE) Teachers will provide home learning activities that match the objectives that they had planned to cover. Teachers will also use the National Oaks Academy to direct parents to online video lessons that most closely match these objectives and subjects. This will be as long as IF THEY ARE WELL ENOUGH TO DO SO. Children have an individual log in for TT Rockstars (Y2-6) and Spelling Shed (Y1-6) which they will be asked to practice every day. They will also be directed to Oxford Owl reading website so they have access to age appropriate reading books online. This will be through the online learning platform Seesaw (and/or Tapes-try for EYFS). **There is an expectation that children send their completed tasks back via Seesaw for teachers to assess, give feedback and ensure that the pupils are achieving and progressing with the home learning.**

Whole school closure or local lockdown

Teachers will communicate with parents through Seesaw so parents can ask if they are unsure what their child needs to do. Teachers or Teaching Assistants will also phone once per week to check on the well-being of the child and answer questions about the work set.

Children do not have access to internet or device A limited number of Ipads will be available to lend to pupils based on need. Paper copies of the resources will be made available to be collected (if it is safe to do so) or will be posted.
