

### Attendance

WELL done to children who achieved 100% attendance last term. They received certificates in Sharing Assembly.

Wagtail Class achieved 97.18% attendance last term; Robin Class achieved 97.39% Owl Class 95.86% and Kingfisher 95.91%.

The whole school attendance for the Autumn term was 96.45%.

Schools are required to keep detailed records about individual attendance on the school computer data system. This has to be forwarded to the Attendance Authority at regular periods. If a child's attendance falls below 90% it is flagged up on the system and you will be informed via letter. Whilst we appreciate that illness cannot be prevented, we encourage parents to ensure their child is in school when ever possible.

A small number of children are arriving late quite regularly. This has an effect on how the child settles in class for the day, how well prepared they are for lessons and whether they have the correct equipment needed immediately to hand. Lateness means that important information given to the class during registration is missed e.g. an introduction to the first lesson after assembly, preparing for the lesson, checking work books and doing corrections required after the teacher has marked work.
